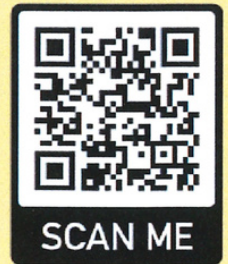
**When** – Saturday, January 13, 2024 – Doors open at 7:30 AM
