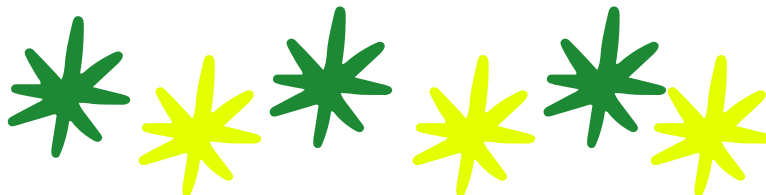

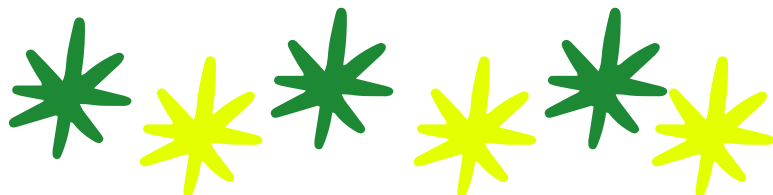
Mission Schedule

DISCIPLESHIP RESOURCE FOR PARENTS

Dear Parents and Guardians,

Do you realize the tremendous impact that you have on your child's faith? Maybe you haven't thought about this before from the perspective of faith.

According to Dr. Christian Smith, author of *Soul Searching* and the National Study on Youth and Religion, after studying thousands of young people, it is clear that when it comes to faith, hands down, parents have the most significant influence on their own children. This journey of faith began in Baptism; each one of us became a new creation in Christ. For Catholics, the Sacrament of Baptism is the first step in a lifelong journey of commitment and discipleship. Whether we are baptized as infants or adults, Baptism is the Church's way of celebrating and enacting the embrace of God. As parents, in the Sacrament of Baptism, you affirmed your support for your child to be formed in faith.

WHAT IS A DISCIPLE?

Did you know that when you were baptized, you began your journey as a disciple?

The word "disciple" comes from the Greek word "mathetes," meaning "pupil/student" of the master. The Master is Jesus and we are his students. We never graduate from discipleship.

Jesus invites each one of us to be his disciple, to follow him, to worship him, and to share him with our friends, family, and the world.

A disciple is a friend and follower of Jesus, who introduces others to Jesus and lives out the Good News.

A disciple of Jesus is someone who:

- Encounters Jesus and grows in intimacy with Him
- Follows Jesus in all aspects of life
- Worships Jesus with a community
- Shares Jesus with others
