We routinely evaluate our safety and security procedures to maintain as safe a building as is possible for our children. Regardless of whether it is in the parking lot for dismissal, a spilled water bottle in the hall, severe weather, or a security concern, we are continually watching and working to ensure a safe environment. Throughout the year we have very pointed conversations and practice procedures for the possibility of unsafe events: fire drills, earthquake drills, tornado drills, and secure classroom drills. In addition to being prepared while at school, we take decisions related to school attendance just as seriously. As we continue through the rainy season and the potential for severe weather, we will take each potential situation seriously while gathering information relative to our families and their safety before making a decision to close school. We appreciate your support as we make decisions based on the information we gather.

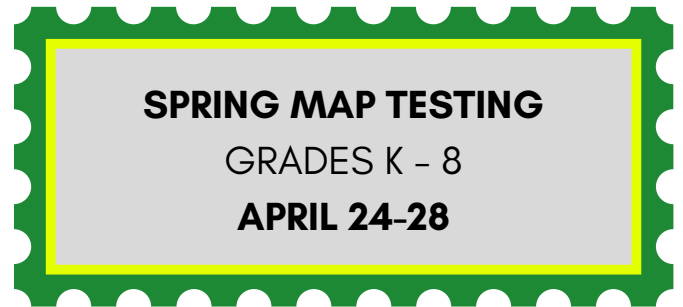


**Uniform Swap**

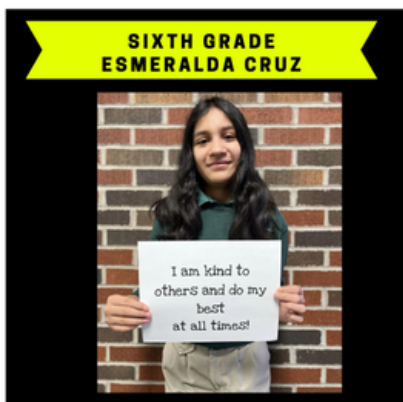
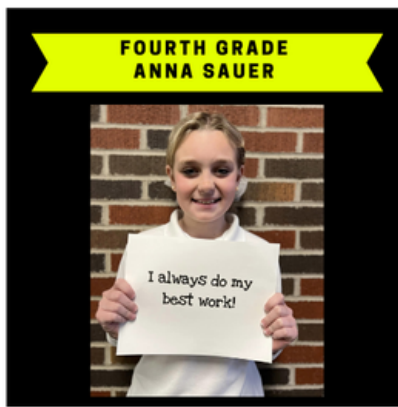
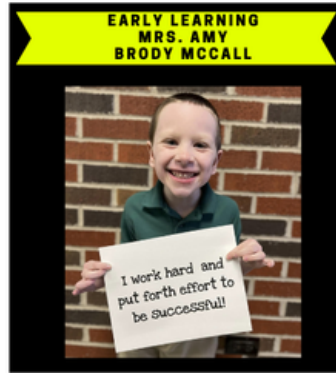
