SCHOOL COUNCIL ELECTIONS

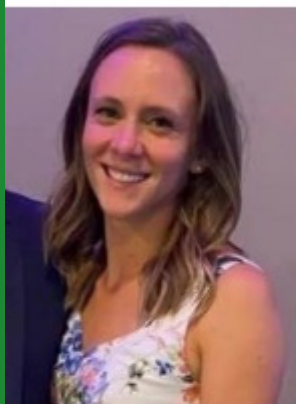
School Council members serve as a consultative body to the school administration, are ambassadors for the school, fulfill annual goals established by the council, and are the Fall Festival Committee.
