## **Announcement of Collaboration with the Institute for School and Parish Development (ISPD)**

As Holy Name School continues to assess the present and plan for the future, we are pleased to announce that we are entering into a strategic planning process over the next 6-8 months with the Institute of School and Parish Development (ISPD). Headquartered in the Greater New Orleans, Louisiana area. ISPD is a national Catholic consulting firm that works with Catholic schools and parishes throughout the country in strategic planning, marketing and overall school resource development.

As our school and ISPD begin the process, here are the key steps:

1. An Executive Committee (EC), made up of school leaders, is already in place. This EC will be responsible for facilitating the strategic planning process and for making final decisions while assuring the steps in the process are communicated to our school families and stakeholders.
2. An ISPD consultant conducted an in-person initial assessment this past summer at Holy Name School with a small group of stakeholders. Through the personal interviews conducted and information or materials provided by the EC, ISPD has identified areas of our school that are impressive, those areas that need improvement or development, and those areas that we can begin to immediately work to improve.
3. A Core Team of 15-20 school/parish representative leaders has been formed to serve as the "steering wheel" to the process.
4. A communication plan will be developed to make sure that our school families are kept informed throughout this process in the coming months, especially how they may become involved.
5. Educational sessions will be conducted with school leaders in regard to overall school development/advancement/enrollment management. These educational sessions will be based upon best practices and proven methods that ISPD has developed for Catholic schools.
6. Ultimately, based upon the ISPD Initial Assessment and upon discussions with the Executive Committee and Core Team, 8-10 challenges will be created in the area of school operational vitality.
7. A Development Advisory Committee of 60 - 80 people will be formed in order to solve the challenges that have been created. They will work together over 3-4 workshops.
8. A school-wide Convocation will be held, in which all school families will be invited in order to offer their solutions to the Challenges that surface in the planning process.
9. Based upon the input, ISPD and the Executive Committee will create the School Strategic Plan of Action for HNS.
10. Communication of the results and priorities of the Strategic Plan will be presented to the school.
11. Implementation will begin immediately after the Final Plan is presented with - hopefully - much involvement from parents, staff, school alumni, parishioners, and friends.

The focus of this process will be built around the theme of personally inviting and engaging people every step of the way. We invite all staff, parishioners, parents, and friends to pray for the success of this effort.

We look forward to this exciting process -- one that will create a plan of operational vitality for Holy Name School, advance the mission of our school and parish community, and bring our school community closer as we continue to build God's Kingdom.
